

Impact of Direct Selling by State, 2021





16.2 million people in the U.S. had signed independent contractor sales agreements with direct selling companies in 2021. Of these 16.2 million, 7.3 million worked to build businesses and 8.9 million were discount buyers who purchased product for their own use but chose not to build a business. These estimated direct sales and people involved figures are extrapolated based on 2022 Growth & Outlook Survey data submitted directly from DSA members.
